We say hello to Miss Hanick, Miss Kirkman and Mr Pillinger who will be teaching in Y3, Y4 and Y5 respectively.

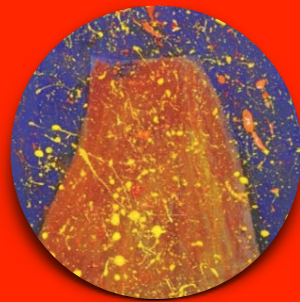
## School Dates
